What is a Beer Mile?

A Beer Mile is an event where an individual drinks a beer and runs a quarter mile four times in succession. So by the end, you'll have run a full mile with four beers in your belly. The relay variety allows four people to participate, each person drinking one beer and running 1/4 mile.

What beer will we be drinking?

Golden Ox. One (or four) 12-oz can weighing in at 5.9% ABV.

When is packet pickup?

Packet pickup begins one hour before the event at 9am. Each participant will receive a bib/timing tracker, participant memento, and a raffle entry.

How many people can I have on my team?

Participants can sign up for either the individual competition or four person relay.

What is the course?

The course will be a ¼ mile loop around Old Ox Brewery.

Do I get swag?

Each participant will receive a memento at packet pickup. Plus you get to start the day off with a beer (or four).

Who is Jenn Miller?

Jenn Miller is the leader of the run club Trottin Oxen. She founded the club four years ago to create a place where runners and walkers of all levels would feel welcome.
